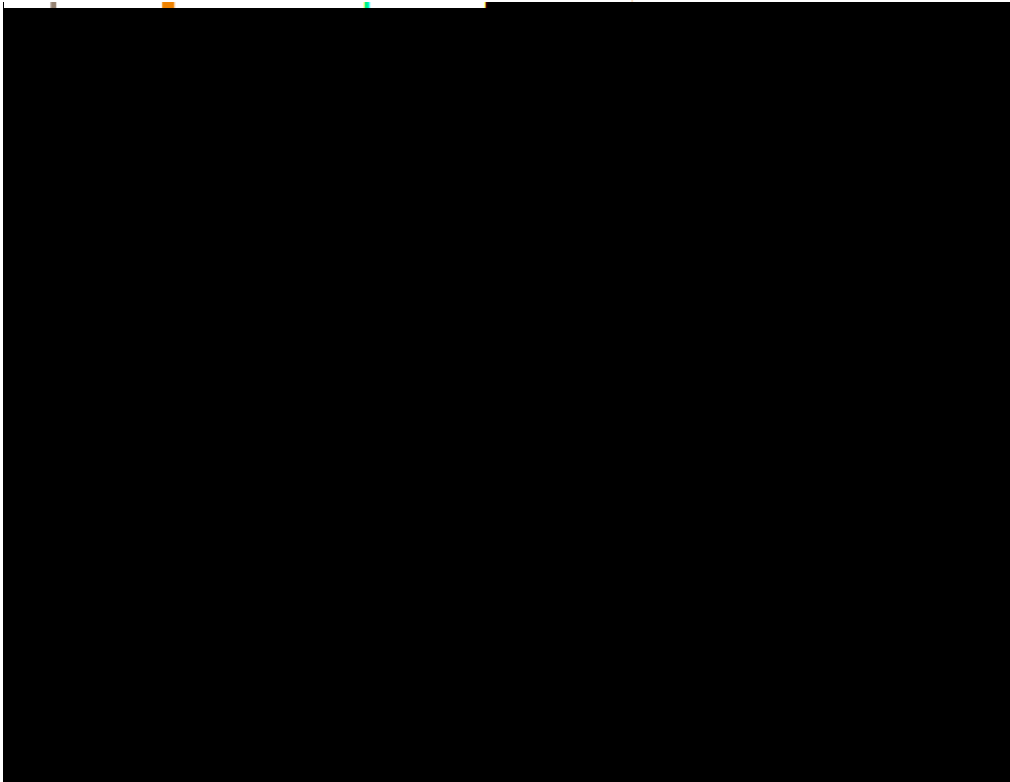
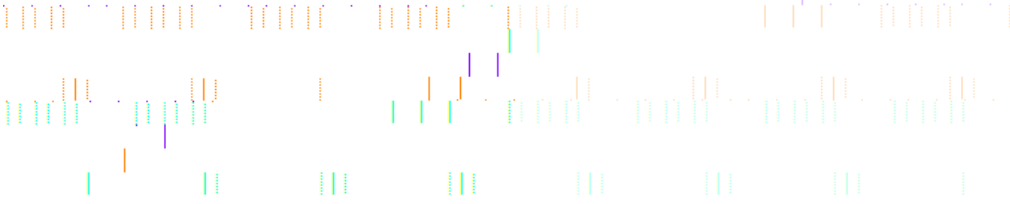


Beginning of Synthetic Dye Production in Japan

Japan relied upon imports for all synthetic dyes until the late 19th century.



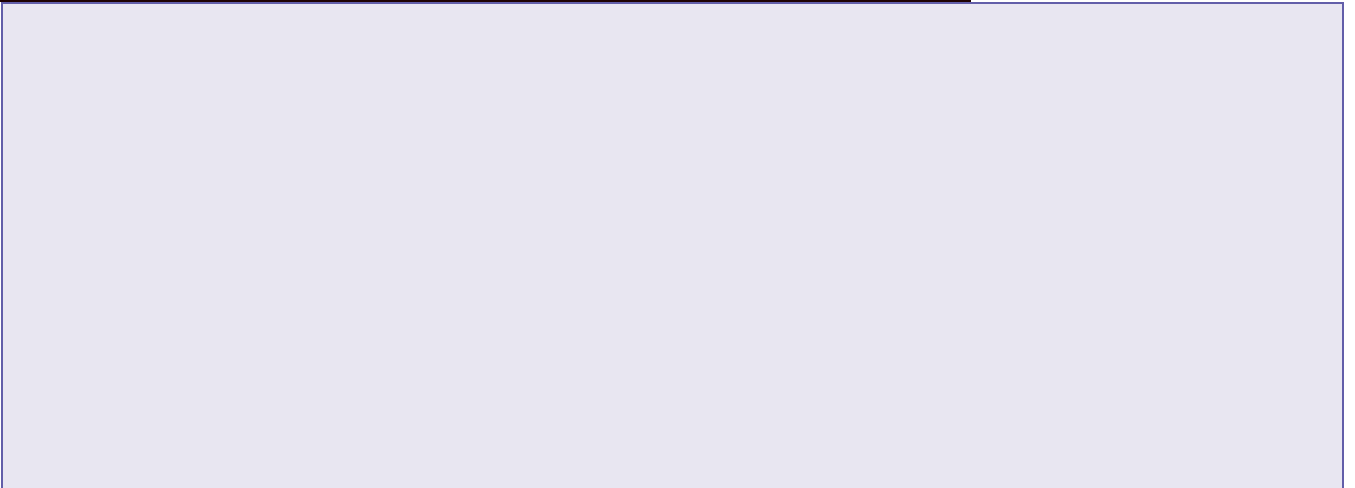
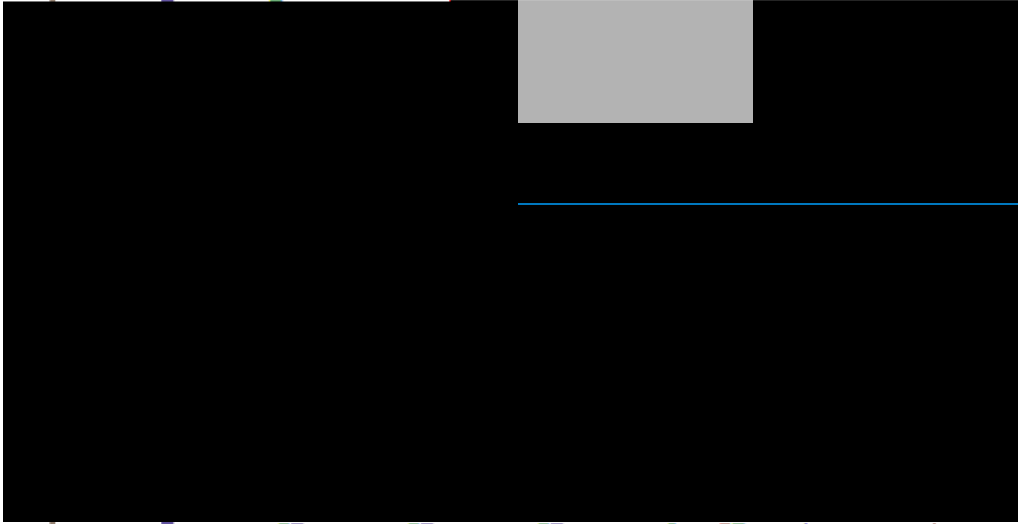
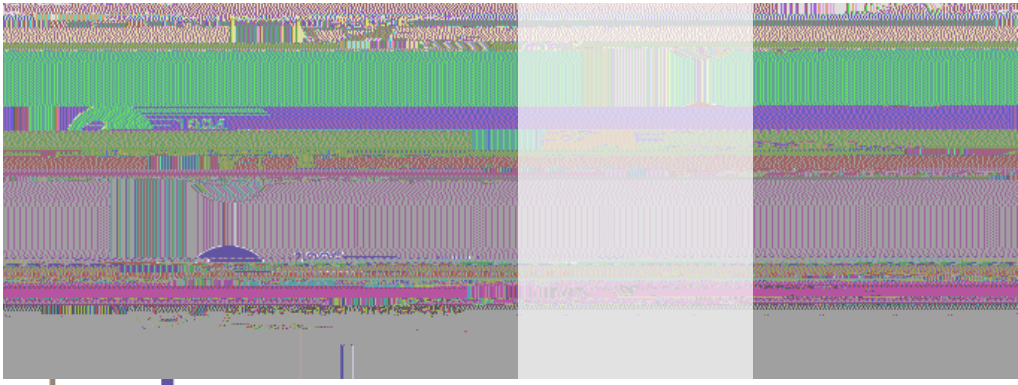
